3rd Grade: Reading 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: Writing

# May 1st-May 14th

3<sup>rd</sup> Grade: Math 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: Reading & Math 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: Reading, Math, & Science

More specific testing information will be coming home in the next few weeks. Please be aware of the testing windows when scheduling appointments. Make-up testing is available, however, students perform better when testing in their familiar environment with the

classroom teacher.
