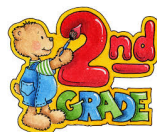
Unit 4: Who We Are

Central Idea: Scientists use scientific principles to understand how the world works.



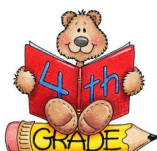
Unit 4: Who We Are
