Theme: Where We Are in Place and Time

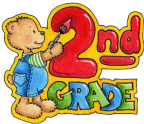
Central Idea: Changes happen over time.

Theme: How We Organize Ourselves

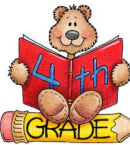
Central Idea: There are many things that affect our decision-making.

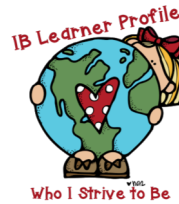

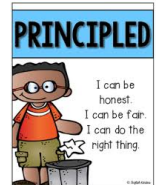

ART-TASTIC

Pre-K- We are using art to express how we feel. We are still exploring lines and different ways we can use them in our artwork.

K- We are making observations and learning how to draw self-portraits. We will be using art to communicate something about ourselves. We are practicing paying attention to details when we draw and color. Different parts of pictures should be different colors.

1st- We are communicating through art. We will make observations about how we look when we have different feelings.

2nd- We are learning about Folk Art. We are using the lines and patterns we have been using in art to create folk art farm.

3rd- We are observing lines in nature. We are creating paintings using lines to show movement in nature. We are observing the structures of Cacti. We are going to discover what happens when we add white or black to a color. We will be learning about value.

4th - We are experimenting with color. We are learning about the color wheel and where to find the intermediate colors. We will use these colors to create a Haiti Tap-Tap bus.

5th - We are observing nature and natural change over time by learning about Antelope Canyon. We are using lines and colors to create our own version of this natural phenomenon.
